

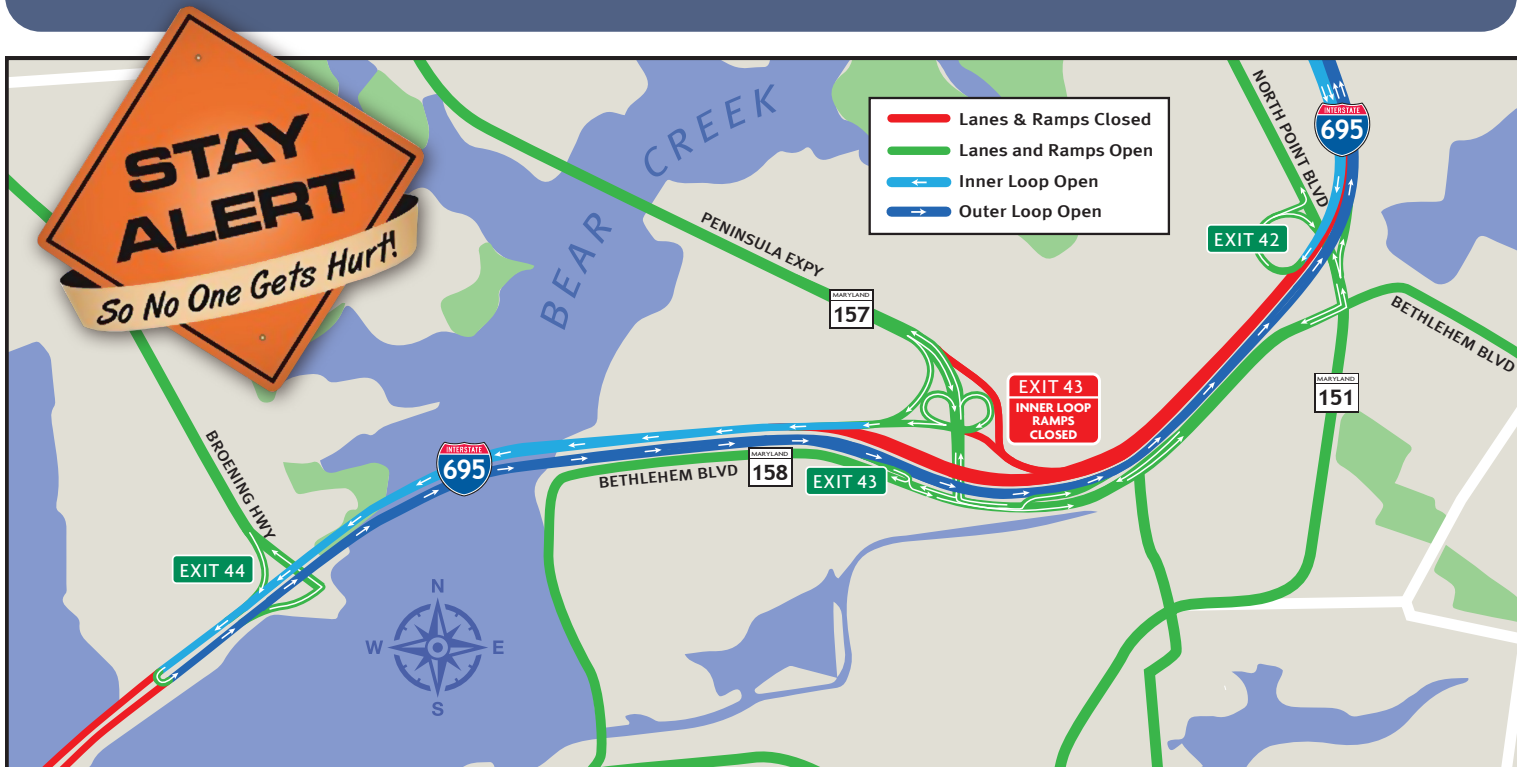
CLOSURES/TRAFFIC PATTERN CHANGES ON I-695 AT SPARROWS POINT NEAR BEAR CREEK



Project Update! Current Traffic Pattern

I-695/Broening Highway Interchange Has Reopened

- Inner loop traffic destined for Broening Highway must use MD 151/North Point Boulevard (Exit 42) and follow detour to return to the Inner Loop.
- The last exit from the Inner Loop remains Exit 42.
- Access to I-695 Outer Loop from Broening Highway is open via existing turnaround; there is no stopping or parking along the loop road.
- I-695 Outer Loop is one lane through the I-695 Sparrows Point Project work zone.
- The Maryland Transportation Authority (MDTA) will reassess the status of I-695 turnaround tolling operations in late August.
